

Packing List for Joint NC-VA Winter Encampment 2019

A Few Things to Note: In order to have the best experience during encampment, please adhere to this packing list and refer questions to your chain of command or winter-enc-da@vawg.cap.gov. *Please watch the weather and plan appropriately (bring cold weather gear, regardless). You may bring additional items if you so choose. Please label your possessions with your CAP ID; thank you!*

BDU/ABU

- 1 full set of BDU/ABUs (minimum - 2 sets are preferred). *BDU/ABU Pants and Blouse*
- 6 black or desert tan crew neck t-shirts (respective of the uniform)
- Uniform Belt (respective of the uniform, black or tan)
- BDU/ABU Cover (NO squadron caps)
- Rank Insignia
- 1 pr Boots
- 6 pairs of boot socks
- 6 pairs of liner socks (similar to dress socks)
- Blousing bands

DRESS BLUES

- 1 full set of dress blues; short sleeve blues shirt, and dress blues pants
- Blues cover with insignia
- 1 white v-neck undershirt
- Dress blues belt
- 2 pair black dress socks
- Dress blues shoes

COLD/INCLEMENT WEATHER GEAR

- Weather appropriate jacket as a minimum
- fleece or other cold weather clothing with no marking or logos (optional)
- 1-2 pair thermal undergarments (optional)
- Rain Jacket or poncho with minimal to no markings and / or logos

PT CLOTHES

- 2 pair black or navy shorts or sweat pants
- 4 gray T-shirts
- Running shoes
- 4 pr white athletic socks

OTHER ITEMS

- 1 pair OLD gym shoes or old boots (may be ruined)
- 6 pair undergarments
- Night/sleep clothes (may wear PT shorts as an option)
- Modest swimsuit (optional to wear in shower)
- 1 pr leather work gloves
- Shoe shine kit
- Clipboard/Binder
- Notepad
- 2 pens/pencils
- 1 Sharpie style black marker
- Flashlight (w/spare batteries)
- Sleeping Bag (bare cots are the only bedding provided)
- Pillow
- 3 disposable plastic grocery bags
- 2 large disposable trash bags
- 2 bath towels
- 1 washcloth (optional)
- Foot powder (optional)
- Travel size soap
- Travel size shampoo
- Toiletries
- 1 pr shower shoes (flip-flops are ok)
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste

Packing List for Joint NC-VA Winter Encampment 2019

- Shaving cream and razor
- Hair brush/comb
- Deodorant (no cologne, body spray or perfume)
- Feminine hygiene products as appropriate
- Any additional items as appropriate e.g. contact lens case and solution, glasses (if worn), spare glasses if contacts wearer, etc.

MEDICAL/MEDICINES

- 7 day supply of all medications (ensure they are appropriately noted on your CAPF 160 series documents)

CONTRABAND

- ALL Electronic devices (no cell phones, handheld electronic games, computer(s) or consumer electronic devices)
- Tobacco, e-cigs, drugs, alcohol, illegal substances
- Sunglasses
- Knives
- Weapons or fireworks
- Lighters or matches
- Snacks, candy, gum, soda, energy drinks, other food items
- Non-prescription drugs, herbs or supplements not listed on CAPF 160 series documents
- If you have questions as to appropriateness then it is probably best to not bring it.

Additional Notes

1. You must have a valid CAP ID with you at all times
2. CAPF 161 with you at all times (left cargo pocket)
3. New boots are not recommended, please try to wear/bring broken-in footwear to prevent blisters
4. Students may bring books to read during personal time, inappropriate reading material(s) will be confiscated.
5. Asthma inhalers or bee sting kits are to be kept in left cargo pocket at all times
6. Laundry service will not be provided please ensure you bring enough clothing for the duration of wENC19
