Laundry Service will not be provided. Be sure to pack enough for the whole week.

Males: Ensure hair is cut recently enough to be within standards on the last day of ENC.

PARENTS: EACH ITEM MUST BE INITIALED ON THE PACKING LIST. DURING STUDENT CHECK-IN, THIS INITIALED PACKING LIST MUST BE PRESENTED.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1. TWO copies of CAPF 160, 161, and 163 as applicable in plastic bag needed for Encampment participation. If these are not present, the cadet cannot participate in Encampment!!!**
 2. Must be able to extend their fingers along the outside leg seam and have fabric left between the fingers and knees.
 3. Students who wish to bring cough drops, lozenges, Tums, or Antacids to Encampment must indicate so on their individual CAP Form 160. Students may not share any nonprescription medication, herbal, vitamin or supplement. All medical supplies are to be brought in the ORIGINAL CONTAINER and labeled with the cadet's last name, first name, and CAPID. Ref CAPR 160-1: 4-3. Written Permission Required for Minor Cadets. No minor cadet may bring any prescription or nonprescription medications, herbals, vitamins, or supplements to any CAP activity without the written permission of the cadet's parent or guardian.
 4. Blues uniform should be fully assembled according to CAPR 39-1, and placed on hangers to avoid becoming wrinkled during travel. A uniform bag is preferred. A second set of uniform insignia dedicated to the blues uniform is recommended to avoid having to transfer insignia.
 5. Watches will not be used as a wakeup alarm due to uninterrupted sleep requirements.
 6. Asthma inhalers and/or bee sting ana-kits are to be kept in the left cargo pocket at all times.
 7. Bring hangers for each individual uniform clothing item you bring - plastic hangers are highly recommended. The two extra hangers will be used for the uniform students wear initially to Encampment.
 8. You must have a valid current CAP membership card to participate in Encampment. The CAP membership card must be with you at all times for the duration of Encampment.
 9. You must have a completed CAPF 161 with you at all times for the duration of Encampment.
 10. Students may bring books if they would like to read during personal time, however, any inappropriate reading material will be confiscated.
 11. Females – practice styling your hair in regs and bring appropriate and travel-sized items to do such.
 12. Gel insoles are HIGHLY recommended for boots. New shoes and boots are NOT recommended! They must be WELL BROKEN IN to prevent against blisters.
